President's Report

2021 was the 50th anniversary of the merger of East Malvern Hockey Club, Victoria's oldest, with Toorak Hockey Club, to form Toorak East Malvern Hockey Club. However, as it turned out, this anniversary year was to be another COVID affected year, but we managed half a winter season until an indefinite lockdown which commenced in June ended the season.

To lose half the season was disappointing. However, the half season played was very positive.

We were very concerned that after next to no hockey in 2020, our player numbers in 2021 might have been very severely depleted. In Seniors, both men and women, the numbers held up extremely well, with the men fielding one less team than 2019 and the women the same number of teams. Juniors, unfortunately, suffered a big fall in numbers, perhaps 20%

TEM's senior Men's teams performed exceptionally well. Our Premier League team was mid table, and a real possibility to play PL finals for the first time in a decade. The Reserves team was lying third when the season ceased.

All Pennant teams were either first or second when the season ceased. As a consequence, next season TEM will have both a Pennant A and B team. TEM will be only one of four Premier League clubs to have both Men's and Women's Pennant A and Pennant B teams.

We do not know what is happening to the lower Pennant grades. There is some talk of a regional Pennant competition below Pennant C.

Adam Luck, Men's Premier League goalie was selected to play with Hockey Melbourne and Oliver Marshall was selected in the Australian Futures squad.

TEM Women too had a good season. The Premier League team finished mid table and were a chance to play finals. The Reserves team was lying fifth when the season ceased.

Pennants B and E both finished second. Pennant B will not be promoted as we already have a Pennant A team. With the potential for a regionalised competition below Pennant C, we are uncertain of what will happen with the Pennant E team.

Summer and Indoor

Now that the covid19 lockdown restrictions have eased TEM is offering a very substantial summer program and I am delighted that the take up rate has been high. Events include:

- Over 80 participants in a social mixed intraclub competition
- 7 senior and 6 junior teams participating in HV's Indoor competitions
- 4 Masters teams participating in outdoor competitions, and
- The highly successful Summer 6s Juniors program run in conjunction with the other Clubs in the Central Flames region.

The Future

Summer hockey has recommenced and an extensive junior program will commence in late January 2022. Junior recruitment and retention will be a key focus of these programs.

Once the season stopped, member engagement again became difficult. TEMPO continued to be published and thank you to all who contributed. However unfortunately two of our major social events did not proceed and we will be looking to increase member engagement in 2022.

At this stage indicators are that we will have a normal season in 2022. There remains a possibility that COVID somehow gets the better of vaccinations.

Finance

As a result of the shortened season, the Committee took the decision to refund 30% of winter fees. (This was in line with the Hockey Victoria team entry fee rebate.)

Our normal operations saw us run at a small loss during the season. However, I am delighted with the support from all those members who donated their fee refund back to the Club which ensures that TEM remains in a sound financial position.

Retirements

Following her move to Newcastle, Christie Freeman retired in March as Women's Vice President, with Penny Senior taking that role and Claire Douglas stepping into the role as Women's Secretary. Unfortunately, Claire will be retiring because she is moving to Ballarat, however she will still be around on match days.

Volunteers

TEM is run by volunteers. They are its lifeblood. They fill the positions and take on the many roles which make TEM run. I thank you all for your efforts.

TEM's Committee consisting of Greg Koster, David Bevan, Penny Senior, Bruce Cook, Joanne Hughes, Leesa Needham, Pip Dudley, Sam Hill, Claire Douglas, Alan Leary, Mary Lofthouse and Pene Amor have given generously of their time to run TEM. Much of what they do is unnoticed, but TEM cannot operate without them. I thank them for their efforts and support.

Finally, thank you the ordinary members, for your continued support and encouragement of me and TEM. TEM exists for you, but without your support TEM would not exist.

Juniors' Report

Although we didn't end up having a complete hockey season this year, it was a step up from 2020 where we had no games at all! We started the year with the Indoor hockey Club Championships where we entered the following teams; U13 Boys (3rd), U13 Girls (3rd), U15 Girls (1st) U18 Girls x 2 teams (2nd & 5th) and U18 Boys (3rd). Our indoor hockey presence is growing each year which is fantastic to see and has a lot to do with the hard work done by Pip Dudley, our indoor coordinator. Thank you Pip for all the work you do with indoor-you're amazing!

During February we ran another 4 week block of our TEM Academy sessions, which we first introduced in 2020. They are designed to develop technical skills, game sense and match play. We had special guest coaches alongside our TEM coaches and also had part of each session run by Jo Bowden from Run Ready to help develop the athletic side of the players.

Earlier in the year we ran a coach's training session with John Mowat which was well received. We will continue to educate our junior coaches and encourage them to complete their coaching accreditation next year and beyond.

At the start of each year we run Hockey Roadshows in local primary schools aimed at introducing hockey to students and recruiting new juniors. This year we visited eight primary schools and had a number of those children come down to junior training and subsequently sign up for the year in U10s or U12s.

In May we had our 'Friday Night Lights' round which was a great success. We had colourful lights set up, music (thanks Braden Pitcher!), delicious food and a big crowd which made for a great atmosphere. Thank you to Liz Murphy who coordinated the parent volunteers to supply all the delicious curries for the night and thank you to all the senior players who came down to support the juniors as ball kids or just to watch. We were lucky to get this event in as the following week, we went into lockdown!

Due to the extended lockdown our junior presentation night this year was held virtually, via Zoom. We had three separate sessions for the different age groups where we presented the Best and Fairest, Coaches awards and Perpetual trophies. We had dropped the trophies off to the winners' houses earlier that day, so the players actually received their awards on the night with was lovely.

During term 4 we are once again playing our Summer 6s competition at HMHC against the Flames teams on Friday nights. We have 3 x U10s, 3 x U12s and 4 x U14 teams playing which is great! We also have six indoor junior teams playing in a 6 week comp. at the SNHC and Monash.

We also have another TEM Academy happening for 4 weeks, so there is lots happening at this time of year as we make up for the lack of hockey during 2021!

Our umpiring program has continued to build in 2021, despite the various challenges, and this is in no small part due to the efforts of several people.

This year the Umpire and Officials program welcomed Annabel Kennedy in the role of Umpire Coordinator for Friday night junior matches. She made the role look easy although I'm sure there were some tricky moments covering some of the games.

We also received an extremely welcome offer of assistance from Phillip Kennedy who has made a valuable contribution in the area of umpire accreditation. He believes that people do want to achieve accreditation and recognition for their efforts, and that they just need some guidance and encouragement to get there. With his assistance we had several umpires achieve accreditation at the Community Level and Level 1. Phillip also made important inroads in reconciling Hockey Victoria records of accredited officials with our own so we now have a much better understanding of who and what our resources are.

Annabel together with Isabel Wright are two of our most accomplished umpires and they both umpire Premier League matches every weekend as well as play Women's Premier League Reserves. This is quite a demanding schedule! As a club we are extremely lucky to have them, as they offer their skills and ability in many ways. They are generous with their time and help coach our developing juniors, they are incredible role models, and they are also always at hand to help find umpires from the wider hockey community to cover matches that are difficult to fill from within the club.

Over the few months that we played matches, we had approximately 10 umpires regularly umpiring junior matches, and another 10 umpires regularly involved in senior and masters umpiring. Importantly, we had three younger umpires – Mackenzie Hughes, Hayden MacPhie and Georgina Kennedy – take the big leap from junior to senior umpiring, and I'm sure that they will all continue their strong development as they become competent and confident to umpire senior matches at a higher level.

Thank you to everyone who has pulled out their whistle and stepped on to a pitch this year, your effort and willingness to help out is always appreciated. Thank you also to every player and supporter who helps to make TEM matches a safe and welcome environment for all officials. It's because we have this inclusive and friendly culture that we are able to attract, develop and retain our umpires.

Hawthorn Malvern Hockey Centre (HMHC) Annual Report to TEM Hockey Club

HMHC is a joint operation with the 2 major tenants at the Hockey Centre in Auburn Rd Hawthorn, being the Toorak East Malvern Hockey Club (TEM) and the Hawthorn Hockey Club (HHC). A third sub tenant Carey Baptist Grammar School (Carey) also are a major user of the facilities.

TEM and HHC each appoint 3 Directors to HMHC, which is tasked with operating the 2 grounds, H-1 and H-2, and the pavilion including the kiosk.

HMHC is represented on behalf of TEM by Rob MacPhie, Miranda Ellis and Tony Dudley with HHC representatives Ross Blair-Holt (Chairman rotating), Russell Kilroe-Smith and Geoff Daley.

2021 Overview

2021 saw a return to hockey across Victoria with the winter competition starting in April. Unfortunately, after 10 rounds Victoria's 6th lockdown called a halt to activity at the end of July. As a result, all activity was put on hold for the Hockey community, with no games played for the rest of the season. Fortunately, as vaccine rates have increased, community sport is again available with the HMHC reopening for hockey on 7 November 2021.

The HMHC Board remained busy focusing attention on all the activities required to get the long-awaited club room redevelopment underway. I am pleased to report that subject to finalisation of funding and overall costs the development start is not far away.

A special thanks to Linda and Grenville, to Harry and Norm for their continued service in what has been another unusual year. Finally, I would like to thank Linda and Norm for their valuable service to the HMHC over many years, as Linda and Norm have informed the Board that they will and have subsequently retired at the end of the current winter season.

Financials

With a 30 June 2021 financial year end, the centre posted a provisional loss for the first time in many years. The financial reports of the centre has just been finalised by the external audit firm Sean Denham and associates and are included with this report. This loss was a direct result of little to no income in the first two quarters to December 2020 with the centre closed. Although we saw a return to hockey in 2021, canteen and school hire income was down. In light of the reduced use of the canteen facilities in 2021, the Board made the decision to reduce the hours of opening the canteen to the high peak times. With the reopening of community sport the centre has many bookings flowing in for next year as schools in particular plan for the 2022 school year.

Club House Redevelopment

Last year the HMHC Board reported that it hoped to get the construction of the redeveloped centre underway at the end of January 2021 with a completion date of June 2021. Unfortunately, this did not eventuate as approvals from council and the land holder, Melbourne Water, were significantly delayed.

Melbourne water insisted on test drilling to confirm the proximity of the clubroom footings to their water tank situated under H1. Hockey users may have noticed this with the disruption to the warmup surface near the stairs down from the club rooms. This work indicated that the water tank was actually much closer to the base of the club room than previously thought and although the plans for the most part were acceptable, the new stairs had to be redesigned resulting in new drawings and further delays.

These delays and the ongoing escalation in material costs such as steel, meant that the overall cost to build has increased by approximately \$500,000 without any change to the agreed plans. This resulted in the HMHC Board seeking councils support in the form of a loan guarantee and to seek funds from Carey Grammar and TEM, noting that Hawthorn Hockey club had committed \$150,000 from the outset.

The good news is that after lengthy internal approval processes at council, they have agreed to go guarantee for a Loan, enabling the Board to finalise a loan with a commercial bank. In line with their ongoing commitment to the centre, Carey has confirmed commitment of \$175,000 and the TEM Committee has also agreed to contribute their share, \$150,000, in instalments over 12 years. A Builder has been shortlisted and final deliberations are underway to meet the overall budget of \$1.7M to \$1.8M.

The new centre will have a large open space for meetings and functions with full viewing of H1, a multipurpose room on the ground level, a larger canteen area, two outdoor decks, a lift, updated toilets and showers with more disability access areas and more storage for clubs. This will make HMHC and the Auburn road complex one of the premier hockey facilities in the state.

Due to the unavoidable time delays and the industry wide escalations in cost, the Board has had to make the hard call to focus on full completion of the structural works and leave out some of the final fittings until after the build is complete. Carpets and equipment for the new canteen area will be sourced post the completion.



New Pitch and Clubrooms Booking system

A new pitch and clubroom booking system has been developed and recently gone live. Bookings will now be using a new web based booking tool that will allow you as users to review availability and make your own bookings. This will be centrally manage by the HMHC Board to ensure fairness and equity in allocation of valuable pitch time.

Together with the new booking tool we have created for the first time a HMHC website to make access to information about the center and bookings much easier.
