

MULTI CLUB PLAYING POLICY

In keeping with the Club's status as a Premier League club, TEM believes that it has a responsibility to support the development of hockey players across Victoria. The Club believes strongly that our ambition to be seen as one of the most diverse, inclusive and supportive clubs in Victoria demands that we uphold the highest standards of support for wider hockey development.

Therefore, we fully understand that circumstances may exist where a:

- junior hockey player may choose to play Junior and Senior hockey at different clubs, or
- senior hockey player may choose to play Senior and Masters hockey at different clubs, or
- player may choose to play winter competitions at one club and indoor/summer competitions with another club.

This may be due to a multitude of reasons which might include friendship cohort, availability of teams, convenience of match/training times/venues or different development opportunities.

TEM recognises that it may not be possible for any Club to "be all things to all people" and hence is fully supportive of players and, in the case of juniors their parents/guardians, who may decide to play hockey with more than one club. These players will always remain part of the TEM community and will always be welcome at the Club.
